Dani is being engaged in terms of acoustic monitoring but suggested Recovery Team members might be keen to review. Guy mentioned that Queensland Government also has guidelines that are out of date and that a global model would be ideal. Developing guidelines is also one of the draft Recovery Plan actions. Artificial nesting - discussion took place around misconceptions surrounding nest boxes as an offset for lost Glossy habitat. Several points were made to reinforce the fact that the SEGBC has not once been known to use artificial nesting and members discussed the challenges around monitoring nesting.
